Christmas Season Schedule





Can you consider a Qualified Charitable Contribution (QCD) to PLC?

Over the past few years PLC has been blessed by some members who have made a significant QCD to our ministry and it has been critical in keeping this lampstand shining. Below is the first paragraph describing QCD's from Fidelity Charitable followed by a link to it for all the details (you will need to type or copy and paste the address into your browser manually). You can arrange for a QCD from your IRA custodian, they all support it. A big advantage of a QCD is you can support PLC's mission with a donation from a traditional IRA that is not subject to federal tax withholding, whereas if you had that distribution paid to you, federal tax would be deducted and less would then be available to offer. If you have any questions after reading the below information and the website contact your IRA administrator. Most administrators (Fidelity, Schwab, TRowePrice etc) allow you to complete the request online with a check of your designated amount sent directly to PLC. From the first paragraph of the Fidelity article:

A qualified charitable distribution (QCD) allows individuals who are 70½ years old or older to donate up to \$105,000 total to one or more charities directly from a taxable IRA as part or whole of taking their required minimum distributions. As a result, donors may avoid being pushed into higher income tax brackets and prevent phaseouts of other tax deductions, though there are some other limitations.

If you are required to take a Required Mandatory Distribution (RMD), pleas consider this opportunity to increase your stewardship at PLC in the amount that would otherwise go to withholding taxes.

Treasurer's Report for December 2024

Merry Christmas to all members, visitors, and friends of Peace Lutheran Church.

Our YTD contributions continue to be over and above the budget and our YTD expenses are under budget. That is a great place to be going into December. God is good! We had three payrolls in October which made our expenses higher than normal. I try very hard not to make every Sunday about raising funds. I thank the Pastor for giving a stewardship sermon this last month.

The Major Roof Fund stands at \$16,487.71 at the end of October. The council has decided to go with a private adjustor, Omega, to help secure funds for the roofs.

Many people give to the Food Pantry, Memorial Fund, Children's Hunger Project, VBS, etc. on a regular basis just by adding that extra amount to your one check and designating the separate funds on your envelope.

The contribution envelopes will be ready for members by the middle of December. If you are not using envelopes now and wish to, please speak to the undersigned or send an email that you would like to use envelopes in 2025. Your tax statements will not be available until after the New Year.

I am currently working with Wes Edwards to take over the Treasurer's job. Thank you Wes for serving.
