### **Dear Friends through Christ:**

Or do we attract more people by letting them know this is a style of worship that makes us whole? Come and See! I don't know about you, but I can't tell you how many times I've walked out our worship experience feeling refreshed and forgiven. I can't tell you how many times that stale piece of bread and cheap wine have gotten me through some exceedingly challenging times. Me personally, I think there are plenty of us out there who can be blessed with our style of worship. The problem is there are too many around us that just don't know what happens inside.

### **Treasurer's Report**

Greetings to all members, visitors, and friends of Peace Lutheran Church.

As you can see below, our contributions have fallen, and our expenses have increased because of the three payrolls in May which have outpaced our income by \$13,756.83. We continue to be in the black in our YTD.

We paid the entire property and liability insurance in May and June from the Savings Account. I will repay savings by transferring an amount equal to 1/12 of the total Property and Liability Insurance from checking to saving each month. This way our expenses won't be off the chart for May and June. Checking with our Mortgage company, Thrivent, we do need to have full insurance coverage until our loans are paid off.

Please consider giving an <u>extra offering (weekly or monthly) (on the same check as your tithe)</u> to the Major Repair Fund for the roof replacement. Just mark it "Roof Repairs" and the extra amount you wish to give. The Major Roof Fund stands at \$12,403 at the end of May. We have three quotes for new roofs on Peace Place and the Sanctuary.

Simply designate the breakdown of your giving in the check's memo area or on the envelope itself. "FP" for Food Pantry, "CHP" for Children's Hunger Project, and so on.


